NHS England has commissioned a new Transition, Intervention and Liaison Service for those leaving the Armed Forces (in transition) and any veteran of HM Armed Forces. This service is for veterans with mental health issues, including complex.

A complete care package is put in place with covers all support needs, for example:

- Housing
- Employment
- Debt
